Bright sparks have turned up the heat on Bonfire Night ticket sales at the Black Country Living Museum where demand for the 5th of November Guy Fawkes extravaganza has rocketed. Tickets are smokin' hot and selling out fast and more than half of the pre-book only tickets have been snapped up!

Bonfire Night - 'Without the Bangers' is one of the region's most talked about Bonfire Night celebrations. Three Bonfires cast an orange glow across the Museum's canalside village which will be lit up by candle and gas light.

The Coseley Male Voice Choir, who celebrated their 60th anniversary in 2008, will be making their debut appearance at this year's event. The sound of old-time music will echo through the streets as a fanfare of barrel organs, showman's organs and a brass band play a medley of popular sing-a-long tunes. Street performers including stilt walkers and jugglers will treat visitors to some old-tyme entertainment.

Fiona Carding, Media Relations Officer said: "This is a traditional family-orientated event that will bring back memories for the older generation and create new memories for the young. We have an unbeatable Bonfire Night
