

Cost

Each visit costs **£6.50** per person.
Please bring a cheque with you on the day of your visit, for the cost of the whole group.
£100 minimum charge per session.

Facilities

Lunch

Visitors are welcome to bring a packed lunch, which may be eaten in the centrally heated education room. For an additional charge of £5 per head, the Museum will arrange tea and coffee during the day and lunch from the nearby sandwich shop.

Shop

Our shop sells souvenirs.

Toilets

The museum has full toilet facilities including a disabled toilet.

Access

Access to the ground floor is available for wheelchair users.

Health & Safety

Unfortunately, access to the upstairs is via a steep staircase. However, picture information cards are available.

A copy of the museum's Risk Assessment can be provided on request.

A first aid box is located in the Museum Reception.

Opening Times

We open for group visits by arrangement and your group will have sole use of the premises.

We are within easy reach of M6 Junction 10.




How to Book


Subject to availability you may book to bring a group on any weekday. In order to gain the most from your visit we advise that the group be comprised of no more than 40 people.
